Dear Parents:

Registration: Our registration period for the 2017-2018 school year took place from January 23rd to February 3rd. Again this year we are not sending home paper copies of the registration form, the expectation is that parents complete it online. This means that if you have not done so yet, your child is not registered for school next year. Please go onto the site and do this a.s.a.p. if you haven't done so already. If for some reason you are unable to register online, please let us know and we will assist you. Also, if you know of any new families who intend to send their children to LES for Kindergarten and haven't registered yet, please encourage them to come in and do without further delay.

Sloppy Weather Ahead: The weather seems to be a little unpredictable these days and it is very important to ensure that your children come to school dressed accordingly. The children spend 15-20 minutes a day at recess and approximately 20-25 minutes each day at lunch, outside. Please make sure that they have hats, mitts etc. on cold days and rain gear, including rubber boots, on wet days.

Unpaid Fees: Just a reminder once again, that when fees go unpaid, everyone suffers. If you have not paid by now, please remember that all unpaid fees will be sent to a collection agency at the end of the year.

Read-a-thon: Thank you to everyone who supported our Read-a-thon this year. As a school, we raised a record total of \$4,729.40. These monies will be used to offset the costs for end of year trips and other extra-curricular activities that take place at the school.

Snow Make-up Day: Please note that due to the snow day that we had, **March 27th** is now a regular school day for all students.
