

Mathematics:

A combination of the *Math Makes Sense* program and the *Numbers Workbook* will be used this year in Grade 3.

The following skills will be taught.

1. Place Value
2. Review of addition and subtraction
3. Regrouping in addition and subtraction facts
4. Multiplication facts
5. Geometry
6. Problem Solving
7. Patterns
8. Measurement
9. Data Management
10. Probability

Homework:

French homework is from Monday to Thursday and involves:

- Reading for 10 minutes
- A short writing component and/or word study

Math homework will be based on skills taught on in class.

French as a second language:

The French as a second language program is based on a balanced literacy approach involving word studies, reading, writing, listening and speaking in French. Children will be asked to interact in French while getting more familiar with the francophone world around them. A large focus will be placed on speaking and listening through relevant and meaningful activities in class.

The students will practice the «Mots de passe» (Power words) on a daily basis, as well as other theme-based vocabulary words. Language centres «Les 5 au quotidien» (the Daily 5) will be done on a weekly basis. Also new

this year, the Grade 3 students will be using the «Littérature en Action» program, where the students will be exposed to a variety of written texts.

Developing confidence and an open attitude towards a second language is an important goal of the French program.

Social Studies:

The study of geography, history and citizenship education is done in French. Through fun and exciting activities, children will develop their understanding of different societies and their territories. They will develop their capacity to interpret change in a society and their openness to the diversity of societies and their territories.
