Bonjour et Bienvenue !

The Cycle I Year work is based on a story, followed by written work in the white booklets and daily vocabulary study at home.

The French program for 1V- Mme Villeneuve (the Green group) and for 1D-Mrs. Dustin (the Yellow group) is every day for a total of 450 minutes per week.

Evaluation – at the end of most stories, the children will have a test. These tests are geared so that the children score highly.

Please note that the mark on the report card includes these test results, but it **also includes** the oral and written work the child does in class, through: -

1. questions and answers period
2. dialogues and discussions
3. vocabulary, phonetics and grammar (in white booklet)

When the children finish their white booklets – about every two weeks, they bring them home. Please go over the work with your child. He/she should be able to identify almost everything in the booklet.

Homework includes vocabulary words to study and occasionally extra worksheets (reading and written work). Please initial the homework sheet every night (in the black duotang).

French level books are in the French Class – Eventually (in the month of November) your child will sign out a French level book. They are to be returned (in one or two days) when they are finished (please make sure to fill the reading sheet in the blue pocket folder.)

Mathematics for 1V – will be taught in English by Mme Villeneuve but please refer to Mrs. Dustin’s curriculum for the math information and homework procedure.

Homework - For 1D (the Yellow group):

- the yellow duotang is French Vocabulary
- the blue duotang pocket folder is for French home reading

For 1V (the Green group):

- the green duotang is French Vocabulary
- the blue duotang pocket folder is for French home reading
- the black duotang for the homework agenda and the 100 math chart study
