Dear Parents,

I hope this email finds you well and enjoying the beautiful spring weather that we are getting.

Please take note of the following:

**School Cancellation:** Please be reminded that as per the email that was sent out from the school board yesterday, there will be no in-person classes for students tomorrow (April 14<sup>th</sup>). As with any situation related to contracts and negotiations, things can change quickly. For this reason, we ask that you check your email regularly, including this evening, in case there are last minute changes. The plan thus far is that students from grades K-2 will be receive a package of work that can be completed at home and students from grades 4-6 will receive online instruction from their teachers. Your child's teacher will be sending you more detailed information today. **Also, please note that there will be no daycare services tomorrow as well.** We understand and regret the inconvenience that this disruption may cause.

**COVID 19 Protocols and Masks:** Please be sure to read all documents that are sent to you from the board regarding Covid in order to ensure that you have the most recent instructions from Public Health. With the new variants that are circulating, it is more important than ever that children and adults follow these protocols. All students from grades 1-6 must wear procedure (medical) masks while in class and while circulating in common areas within the school. Masks have been provided for grades 5-6, but unfortunately, we have not yet received enough masks for grades 1-4 so in the meantime, please send a face covering or procedure mask with your child in the morning. Once we have received the masks for the younger children, we will distribute them and let you know.
